- ➔ Many natural materials contain strong dyes; examples are carotene in carrots, curcumin in turmeric and astaxanthin in some fish and seafood.
- ➔ These dyes can make the cleaning process of belts difficult and while they do not present a biohazard, they distort visual inspection of the belt.
- ➔ Volta has introduced two new blue shades developed to counter this issue and which enable a factory to assess the status of a belt more easily.
- ➔ We trust this gives QA better service and leaves a clearer picture of belt status for food auditors when processing these specific food products.
